Scholarship Program

The Ontario Professional Engineers Foundation For Education provides scholarships to outstanding engineering students at accredited Ontario universities.

The Foundation welcomes gifts, bequests, and legacies from individuals and corporations. Please include the Foundation in your plans for voluntary donations each year.

Purpose

The Foundation's objective is to reinforce high standards and professional competence through rewarding academic achievement and giving students an understanding of the traditional values of the profession so that they can accept the responsibilities of becoming professional engineers.

The Foundation also provides temporary financial assistance to professional engineers and their families in extenuating circumstances.

The Foundation maintains a fund for donations and sponsorships to support an Engineer-In-Residence initiative that provides volunteers to support science and mathematics curricula in schools across Ontario.

Scholarship Program

The foundation provides scholarships to encourage engineering students to pursue careers in the profession. The scholarships are financed through donations from Ontario professional engineers. In 2001, professional engineers donated over \$73,000 to the Foundation.

Entrance Scholarships

The Foundation awards annual entrance scholarships valued at \$1,500 each to one male student and one female student at all of Ontario's 13 accredited engineering schools, for a total value of \$39,000. Recipients of entrance scholarships must have attained high academic standing in their final year of high school and be well-rounded students who exhibit characteristics of leadership.

Undergraduate Scholarships

In addition, the Foundation awards scholarships valued at \$1,000 each to undergraduate engineering students in subsequent years of their study. The number of scholarships at each university varies according to the size of its student population. At each university, half of these scholarships are awarded to students who exhibit exceptional role model qualities through participation in non-academic activities while maintaining above average grades; the other half are awarded on the basis of high academic standing.

Foundation for Education Gold Medal

The Foundation awards a Gold Medal (no cash value) to the student in each faculty who achieves the highest standing in the final examinations of his or her final year.

Scholarship Recipient Selection

In all cases, the individual award recipients are selected by the Dean and/or Faculty Council of the engineering school. Every effort is made to arrange or participate in a suitable awards ceremony at which the scholarships can be presented by a representative of the Foundation. These awards provide an opportunity for the engineering profession in Ontario to demonstrate its commitment to the development of future professional engineers.

Governance

The Foundation is an independent, non-profit, charitable organization established by Professional Engineers Ontario. The Foundation is governed by a Board of Directors elected annually by its members. The Officers of the Foundation, which include the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer, are elected or appointed by the Board at its first meeting following the annual general meeting of members.
